The Quality Lead will establish and lead a practical quality management framework across Project Delivery, Supplier/Contractor performance and Asset Operations. The role will support the Delivery team by ensuring that quality services provided by Project Management Assistance /Owner's Engineer and other external parties are clearly defined, appropriately resourced, commercially recognised where additional scope is required, and delivered in line with project expectations. The role will help ensure quality standards are clearly defined, consistently applied and effectively monitored from development and construction through handover and into operational life.

This is a cross functional role focused on setting expectations, verifying compliance, escalating risks, improving processes and building quality capability across teams. Initial priorities will include making key supplier and project quality risks visible and standardising templates and reporting.

As the business grows, the role will move from directly managing quality activity to delegating routine checks, using dashboards and trend data, and driving improvements in supplier performance, handover quality and cost of poor quality.

You'll play an important role in:

Protecting project and operational performance by ensuring Suppliers, Contractors, internal teams, processes, risks, NCRs, handovers and lessons learned are managed through a clear quality framework. You will help define and embed practical quality controls, support Delivery and Operations teams, and build quality capability across the business as it grows.

- Commercial awareness of cost, risk, handover quality, and supplier performance
